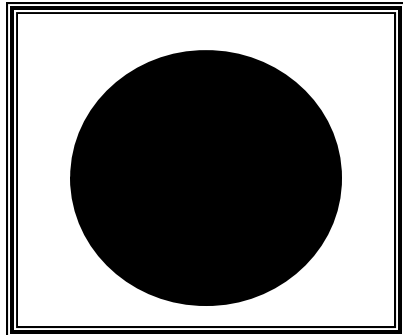


WEATHER CONDITION CODE SHEET

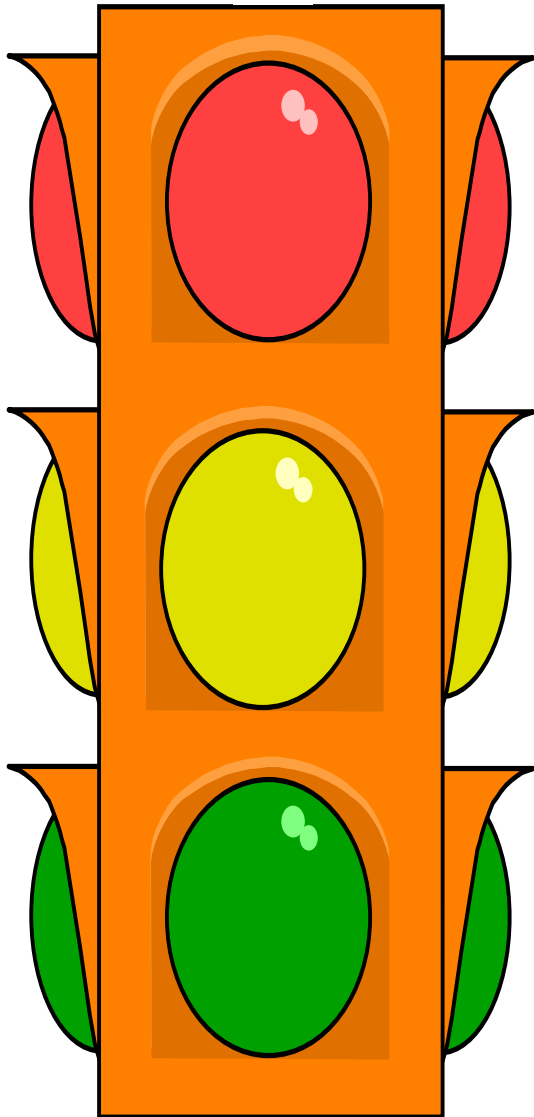
To Find out Current Codes and Conditions Listen to WZBD 92.7FM



CODE BLACK- LEVEL 4

1. Declared Snow Emergency by Commissioners/ Mayor
2. County Roads are drifted shut
3. County Offices **will be closed**
4. Encourage the suspension of all business

*Private Business decides whether employees need to report for work.
*No color code dictates work stoppage for private Business.



CODE RED- LEVEL 3

1. Stop, Think Twice About Driving
2. High winds and drifting occurring
3. Roads are totally snow and ice covered
4. County roads are mostly drifted shut and impassable

CODE YELLOW- LEVEL 2

1. Use Extreme Caution When Driving
2. Severe difficulties in driving are present
3. Moderate winds and drifting occurring
4. Roads are mostly snow or ice covered

CODE GREEN- LEVEL 1

1. Roads are Partly snow and ice covered
2. Some drifting of county roads occurring
3. Extra time is needed for stopping
4. Light winds occurring

WEATHER CONDITION CODE SHEET

Weather data shall be routinely and immediately dispersed to the public by the Adams County Sheriff's Communication Center. This weather data is received from two sources and through our computer terminal:

1. National Weather Service- North Webster
2. Mx Vision Storm Sentry Weather System

The Adams County Sheriff's Communications Center can activate local alert systems via radio.

Local and area new media also provides up-to-date weather information for you. We advise you to listen to **WZBD 92.7 FM** for current Codes, Conditions, and Closing in Adams County.

The Adams County Sheriff's Department will assist you with your Emergency Needs. They can be contacted at 724-7141. **In emergency situations Call "911"**.

In a declared Snow Emergency the Adams County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) can assist Key Officials in getting to and from their facilities. Key Officials are Doctors, Nurses, Pharmacists, and others who **MUST** get to work.

The Stop Light design is used to help citizens make good decisions when deciding whether or not to drive in adverse conditions.

Green (level 1)- **Go** with care

Yellow (level 2)- **Caution**, road conditions are poor

Red (level 3)- **Stop**, don't go

Black (level 4)- Snow Emergency Declared by the Commissioners

County road conditions are used in code making decisions remember that road conditions in town are usually better. State Highway Department's activities are not considered in code making decisions.

Employees should report to work in any code **unless** otherwise informed by their **employer**.
